# The Role

## **Trustee Board**

The Trustee Board consists of parents, medical and clinical staff and business individuals, each bringing their own unique skills. We are recruiting a new Independent Trustee to join the Board.

It is not necessary to have previous board/trustee experience as training will be provided. We welcome applications from all ages and backgrounds. We particularly want to recruit more women, young people and people of colour to increase diversity across the board.

We are looking for skills and experience in one or more of the following:

- Fundraising strategy and performance
- Business Development
- Law/Legal
- Health and Safety

### The Statutory Duties of a Trustee

- To ensure that the organisation complies with its governing document, charity law, company law and any other relevant legislation or regulations
- To ensure that the organisation pursues its objects as defined in its governing document
- To ensure the organisation uses its resources exclusively in pursuance of its objects: the organisation must not spend money on activities which are not included in its own objects, no matter how worthwhile or charitable those activities are
- To contribute actively in giving firm strategic direction to the organisation, setting policy, defining goals and setting targets, and evaluating performance
- To safeguard the good name and values of the organisation
- To ensure the effective and efficient administration of the organisation
- To ensure the financial stability of the organisation
- To protect and manage the property of the charity and to ensure the proper investment of the charity's funds.

#### **Other Duties**

In addition to the above duties, each Trustee should use any skills, knowledge or experience they have to help the Board of Trustees reach sound decisions. This may involve:

- Scrutinising board papers
- Leading discussions
- Focusing on key issues
- · Providing guidance on new initiatives
- Other issues in which the trustee has special expertise

#### We are looking for someone who has:

- Worked with or has knowledge of diverse communities
- Willingness and approachability to deal with enquiries from staff or trustees
- Ability to make recommendations to the board of trustees based on sound advice.

This role is subject to an enhanced criminal record check, which is processed through the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS), and a 'Fit and Proper' person's declaration.
