Each year, over 150 children in Yorkshire are diagnosed with cancer. When a child is diagnosed, lives are turned upside down instantly: not just for the child but the entire family. Getting well again can be a long and challenging journey, emotionally, physically, and financially. Supporting children and families throughout that journey is why our charity, Candlelighters, was formed more than 50 years ago.

We understand the complexities and impacts of a childhood cancer diagnosis, and our mission is to bring light and hope to families facing childhood cancer in Yorkshire.

We aim to do this by:

- **Providing emotional, practical and financial support to families.** This includes expert support such as talking therapies, wellbeing services and support groups, holidays, day-to-day support on the wards and financial grants.
- Delivering our range of high-quality family support services for whenever and wherever we are needed, from the point of diagnosis, during and after treatment, and for those families who are sadly bereaved.
- Supporting and strengthening the NHS centre of excellence in Yorkshire by funding crucial, front-line hospital roles.
- Investing in vital research, education and training to improve the outcomes and lives of children and their families affected by childhood cancer both across Yorkshire and further afield.

The Role

Purpose of the Role

This is an exciting time for the Fundraising Team as we aim to grow income and continue to provide our services to families. You will support Community fundraising efforts, ensuring all our community fundraisers have an excellent experience supporting Candlelighters.

You will play a key role in helping to build education-based fundraising initiatives and support existing and prospective community supporters, strengthening community engagement and generating sustainable income.

Responsible to

Senior Regional Fundraiser.

Hours

Minimum one day per week between 9am - 4pm in the office, but can vary depending on supporter needs (with flexibility to attend cheque presentations, offsite events, and stakeholder engagements).

Location

Office based. Candlelighters, Woodhouse Square, Leeds, LS3 1AD

Key Activities

- Researching and identifying new education settings and partnership opportunities.
- Conducting market research into education fundraising initiatives and offerings.
- Attending community-based cheque presentations and engagement events.
- Delivering talks and presentations at school assemblies.
- Processing community fundraising mailings, including mail merges.
- Thanking supporters through telephone calls, letters, and emails.
- Responding to supporter enquiries via telephone and email.
- Providing administrative support and preparing resources and equipment for supporter events.
- Updating and maintaining the supporter database.
- Perform other administrative tasks to support the fundraising team.

We're looking for volunteers who:

- Confident speaking with schools, supporters, and community groups.
- Comfortable attending community events and delivering presentations.
- Ability to build positive relationships with supporters and partners.
- Possess strong administrative and organisational skills.
- Are proficient in IT, including Microsoft Office, and have experience working with databases.
- Have experience communicating professionally via telephone, email, and in person.
- Are friendly and approachable while maintaining professional boundaries.
- Show strong attention to detail.
- Follow Candlelighters' policies and procedures.
- Uphold and demonstrate the Candlelighters values.

This role is subject to an basic criminal record check, which is processed through the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS).

Please note that volunteers must be 18 or over, and we are only able to accept applications from UK residents, due to insurance, safeguarding, and logistical requirements associated with our volunteer programme.

- Our building has steep stairs and no lift access. We recognise that this may present challenges for individuals with mobility needs.
- We use a hot desking system (employees and volunteers do not have fixed desks). We understand that this setup may not be ideal for everyone, and we are open to discussing potential adjustments to accommodate individual needs.
